Report of Investigation Apr 28 2023 On Oct.

12, 2010, the Office of the Ohio Inspector General (OIG) received an anonymous complaint alleging misappropriation of funds at the Ohio Department of Insurance (ODI). The complainant alleged ODI submitted proposals to the Ohio Dept. of Administrative Services to reclassify certain employees, which would allow ODI to increase the employees' pay around the time that the Ohio Civil Service Employees Association union contract was being negotiated. These reclassifications would ensure certain employees would not lose money when the step freeze and cost savings days included in the union contract were implemented. The information in the anonymous complaint led to the opening of an additional investigation by the Office of the OIG involving various personnel actions which warranted further analysis. This analysis included a review of employees who received multiple pay rate increases during a six-month period, excessive pay rate increases for employees assigned to temporary work levels, and violations of the hiring control process.

Report of Investigation Feb 26 2023 The Office of the Ohio Inspector General (OIG) received a referral from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (ODJFS) Chief Inspector's Office. The ODJFS Chief Inspector's Office alleged an ODJFS employee improperly accessed the confidential personal information of a former ODJFS employee through the Ohio Job Insurance program. A preliminary investigation conducted by the ODJFS Chief

Inspector's Office determined former that the former ODJFS employee's confidential personal information records had been accessed by two Department customer service representatives in March 2011. On April 20, 2011, the Office of the OIG, in conjunction with the Ohio State Highway Patrol, initiated an investigation into this matter.

There are system foul-ups that keep blood test results from being delivered on time, careless record keepers, shortages of everything except forms to fill, recalcitrant and greedy insurance reimbursement systems, and the surprising difficulty of getting doctors to wash their hands. This is the dynamic universe of small and large concerns and personalities that, taken together, determine the nature of our care and assume the utmost importance. As Martin Payson—chairman of the board at Maimonides and ex-Time-Warner vice chairman—puts it: “Hospitals have a lot in common with the movie business. You’ve got your talent, entrepreneurs, ambition, ego stroking, the business versus the creative part. The big difference is that in the hospital you don’t get second takes. Movies are make-believe. This is real life.”
