Within each host tree section, flow-chart keys, understandable to the layperson, are provided to lead the reader to individual species or groups of similar organisms, with full-colour illustrations to confirm the identity of the insect or mite. The accompanying biological sketch for each insect or mite usually includes information on the necessity for control, based largely on Forest Insect and Disease Survey records. Where control is necessary, methods are suggested. Common names of insects are also given in the text.
