It includes readings and reflections about Ita and her spiritual tenets, suggestions for scriptural prayer related to her observations, and short prayer services for individuals and groups using ancient Celtic prayers. It also offers spiritual exercises designed to strengthen your spiritual resilience as you into the world around you through acts of social generosity as "citizens of heaven" and as articulate witnesses to God's kingdom.
